HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY:

- Undertake regular, recorded risk assessments of the TRAC site including the children's play area, courts, the pavilion and surrounding areas.
- Create a safe environment by putting Health and Safety measures in place as identified by the assessment.
- Appoint a member of the committee to assist with Health and Safety responsibilities
- Ensure all users of TRAC are aware of, and follow TRAC's Health and Safety measures
- Ensure all main users of TRAC agree to abide by Terms and Conditions of use.
- Provide access to first aid facilities
- Report any injuries or accidents sustained whilst on the TRAC site to the Health and Safety Officer
- Ensure that the policy is reviewed annually and monitored for effectiveness

- Co-operate with TRAC on Health and Safety issues
- Correctly use any equipment provided by TRAC
